

Publication of the dissertation in the University library (Status 04.12.2023)

To complete the Ph.D. graduation process your dissertation has to be published by submission to the University library. Please correct the revisions of your dissertation eventually requested by your Ph.D. committee before submission to the library. You have one year to complete these revisions and publish your written thesis following your thesis defense.

Aside from modifications, which might have been requested by members of your Ph.D. committee or minor editorial corrections (e.g. typing errors, misspellings, or grammatical mistakes), other changes in your dissertation are not allowed. The deposited copies have to be identical in content to the copies evaluated during your Ph.D. graduation procedure.

If parts of your cumulative dissertation are under submission of a scientific journal when submitting your thesis to the dean's office and are later accepted by the journal, this cannot be added to your thesis because the library copy must be identical in content to your original dissertation, which was evaluated by your Ph.D. committee.

When submitting your dissertation to the University library, a certification confirming the submission of your depository copies will be issued. Additionally, your first Ph.D. thesis supervisor has to confirm in a written statement that you are allowed to receive your degree certificates. After submission of both documents to the dean's office (igb@rub.de), you will receive your final Ph.D. degree certificates in both German and English.

Only after receiving the final Ph.D. certificates are you officially allowed to hold the academic doctor's title Ph.D. or Dr. rer. nat..

All possible options to publish your depository copies are located in the doctoral degree regulations. **In case of cumulative dissertations it is recommended to submit 3 printed copies.**

The most cost-efficient option is the "**electronic publication**" (doctoral degree regulations 2016 and 2023: 2 printed copies of your dissertation and electronic version (upload or 1 copy burned on CD). Information about the required data, the file format, and maybe about labeling of the CD is available at the University library. After submission of the dissertation at the library the thesis will be published on the internet.

The publication by the library can be held back for a certain time upon request. For more information please contact the dean's office (igb@rub.de).
